

Terms of Accreditation – Privacy and General Information

The accreditation is based on a valid e-mail address, which is used to create or reactivate an account in the festival database Filmchief. In order to activate the account, an individual password must be entered or newly set up.

All accredited persons are listed on a delegate register with their photo, first name, surname, job title and the name of their company/organisation. This register will only be made available to other accredited professionals. It is possible to directly get contacted, but your email address will only be published with your consent.

The association Independent Cinema, which organises the festival, collects and stores the data in the festival management software Filmchief. Only members and representatives of Independent Cinema have access to this data. Under no circumstances will the data be passed on to third parties. The evaluation of the data takes place exclusively in the context of festival-related activities, e.g. call for submissions or invitations to events.

The individual and personal data stored by Independent Cinema can be viewed or their deletion requested at any time. An informal written message is sufficient for this purpose. The information about Filmchief is subject to the privacy policy. You can find the privacy policy here:
